Volunteer Job Title: Connect Sunday School Volunteer (fourth through sixth grade)

Reports To: Becca Bateman, Associate Pastor for Education and Family Ministries

Time Commitment:

- Connect is held on a weekly basis on Sunday mornings from 9:30-10:15am, during the program year.
- In addition to being present during class, this role may require some preparation time.
- In order to maintain consistency, we ask Connect volunteers to fulfill at least a full one-year term, but they are encouraged to serve for longer.

Purpose: Connect volunteers support the faith formation of fourth, fifth, and sixth graders by being a consistent presence who welcomes each child (and their family) to the love of Doylestown Presbyterian Church and helps them to form a relationship with Jesus Christ and one another.

Duties: Connect volunteers are responsible for the following:

- Arriving at least 15 minutes prior to the start of class
- Learning each child's name within two weeks of the start of Connect
- Welcoming each child as he or she arrives
- Preparing each lesson in a timely manner and being prepared to lead, if necessary
- Taking weekly attendance
- Regularly praying for the children in this class
- Working with staff and other volunteers to ensure that two non-related, CPP-trained adults are
 present at all times when children are in the classroom

Requirements and Training:

- All Connect volunteers must go through Doylestown Presbyterian Church's Community Protection Program (CPP) certification process, including an application, background checks, and a brief training. CPP certification is valid for five years.
- We seek volunteers who are able to share God's Word with younger youth in ways they can
 understand, apply to their lives, and express to others, as well as provide them with an environment
 conducive to faith formation and the development of connections between participating youth and
 adults.
