Volunteer Job Title: Senior Adult Ministry (SAM) Subcommittee Member

Reports To: DeeDee Cox, Moderator

Time Commitment:

- The Senior Adult Ministry Subcommittee meets, as needed, on the second Wednesday of the month at 9:30am, and meetings generally last about an hour.
- In addition to attendance at meetings, subcommittee members have some duties to carry out that are aligned with the mission of the subcommittee.
- There are no term limits imposed on subcommittee members (except for the Moderator, who has a three-year term limit). New subcommittee members generally begin in June, though they can also join the subcommittee at other times of year, at the discretion of the Moderator.

Purpose: The purpose of this role is to support the DPC strategic plan by coordinating educational and fellowship events of interest to mature adults.

Duties: Members of the SAM Subcommittee are charged with inspiring the adult church community to participate in programs that allow them to connect with God, grow in faith, and share in fellowship, specifically:

- The worship of God through meetings and activities that are inclusive of church members and guests
- The growing of faith through the creation of well-rounded programs attractive to adults of all ages
- The recognition and honoring of those who have been members of the church for 50 years or longer
- The provision of an annual Summer Spiritual Renewal multi-day event and a three-day fall retreat

Requirements and Training:

- We seek subcommittee members who are creative, collaborative, hands-on, and resourceful.
- No specific training is required to serve on the Senior Adult Ministry Subcommittee.
